The Sisters of Divine Providence have a strong tradition of educating in the Diocese of Pittsburgh and other dioceses in the United States. It is beyond the imagination of any Sister that someone could enter her classroom with a weapon of mass destruction and slaughter students, faculty and staff. What you have done should make this far less likely.

Thank you for taking the position of immediately ending sales of all assault-style rifles, raising the minimum age to purchase firearms to 21, banning high capacity magazines and bump stocks, requiring universal background checks that include relevant mental health information and previous interactions with the law, ensuring a complete universal database of those banned from buying firearms, and closing the private sale and gun show loophole that waives the necessity of background checks.
